- Creating BOMs from the designs provided and ensuring all relevant data is recorded
- Producing full BOM lists and provide same to the production team/project engineer
- Ensuring all information is accurate, up-to-date and that all parts are labelled with correct descriptions
- Liaise with design team/engineering manager on all discrepancies found to ensure any re-design work is undertaken
- Work to a project plan and meet the agreed budget costs and timeframes
- Respond to any queries from the sales team, design team, engineering manager, production team or Senior Managers
- Source materials and parts as and when required

Person Specification

- Minimum of two years' in mechanical design
- 3D modelling experience and use of a Product Data Management system is essential.
- 2D modelling experience
- Sound knowledge of manufacturing techniques and processes is desirable.
- Preferably have a recognised third level qualification in mechanical design (although not essential).
